How do we Tithe?

Tithe is our commitment to share 10% of our blessings with those around the world who are in need of decent housing. Yakima Valley Partners Habitat for Humanity supports the builds of homes in El Salvador and Nepal.

Why should we tithe?

The operational decision to tithe is based on Habitat's biblical roots as an ecumenical Christian ministry. It is also a visible acknowledgment that our mission is global and that our vision requires that every person everywhere has safe and secure housing.

GLOBAL MISSION FUND:

To be used where most needed to help families outside the US secure decent shelter.

ORPHANS & VULNERABLE GROUPS FUND:

To provide housing solutions for the most vulnerable, such as orphans and ethnic groups facing persecution.

INTERNATIONAL DISASTERS FUND:

To respond immediately to natural disasters as they occur. Funding may also be used for responses to protracted humanitarian emergencies.
